#### HEALTH EFFECTS

## FIRST AID

SKIN : Immediately wash contaminated skin with plenty of water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. If irritation occurs seek medical advice.

EYES : Immediately irrigate with copious quantities of water for at least fifteen minutes. Eyelids to be held open. Remove clothing if contaminated and wash contaminated skin. Seek immediate medical advice.

INGESTION : Thoroughly rinse mouth with water and induce vomiting. Use fingers in throat or use Ipecac Syrup (APF).

### EXPOSURE LIMITS

### STORAGE AND TRANSPORT

### SPILLS

Slippery when spilled. Avoid accidents, clean up immediately. For liquids use absorbent (soil or sand, inert material, vermiculite). Collect and seal in properly labelled drums for disposal. Wash area down with excess water.

For small quantities, wash area down with large quantities of water.
